**What's for lunch?**

7 Raytown parents have more control than they once did over their child's answer to that question.

The district's online Mealpay system lets parents peek at what their kids bought in the lunch line minutes before, or replenish the lunch account.

Parents can also veto some purchases before they're ever made.

"A parent can call and say, 'I don't want my child to buy such and such,' and when the kid comes through the line, a message will come up," said food service director Nancy Coughenour.

The most common restrictions involve food allergies and a la carte items.

"We want the parents to be in charge," she said. "I'm hoping mom logs in and sees what her child had for lunch, then asks, 'How did you " like the pizza?'"
